What is the funding rate?

Norway Health Tech: The funding rate depends on each National funding. Information for Norway will be presented next also available in the presentation pdf. For the other countries you must check the national guidelines on the AAL website call 2021.

What does the national budget mean?

AAL Programme representative: Every country commits a different budget; you can have country A committing budget 10 and country 2 committing budget 15

What is the relation of the national budget and the project proposal budget?

AAL Programme representative: There is no relation (even if for some countries there are thresholds in terms of max public contribution)

If we want to submit a proposal with partners in Norway, Portugal and Spain what is the max budget that we can apply?

AAL Programme representative: max funding (public contribution) for SCPs is 300K euros, while for CPs is 2.5M euros. as mentioned above, there might be thresholds in some countries - pls check here

Does the risk requirement give an advantage to companies that could afford the research without the ALL program? How many small startups got funded?

AAL Programme representative: AAL did fund a number of start-ups, yet the eligibility has to be checked against national rules. We also support StarUps (SMEs and other) via AAL2Business - pls check <https://www.aal2business.com/>

After submitting in May, when will the projects know if they have funding or not?

AAL Programme representative: Ranking list is expected to be approved by AAL GA in September and notification of results will happen by mid September
