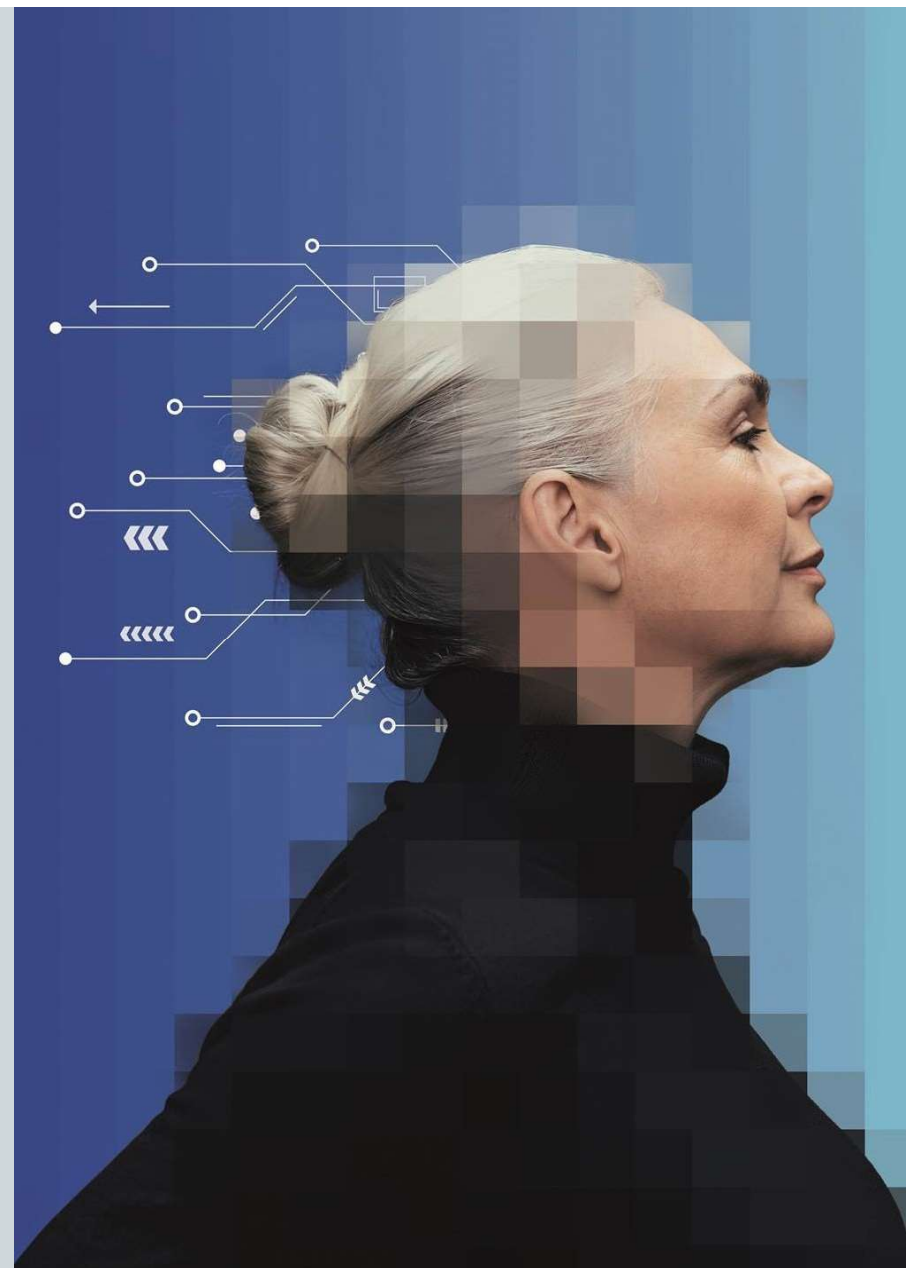

NORWEGIAN PARTICIPATION IN AAL 2021 CALL

- National Budget: 450 000 EUR.
- Collaborative Projects : YES
- Small collaborative projects : YES
- Results from the 2020 call:
 - Success rate and threshold score: 24%
 - lowest score funded: 15/25
 - Number of projects granted with Norwegian participants : 6 (5 SCP, 1 CP)



NATIONAL SELECTION PROCESS

- Norway Grants all top ranked project until the allocated budget for the call is spent
- After initial allocation, if there is unspent Norwegian budget and there are organisations in the ranking above threshold and not granted, Norway can decide to participate in re-configuration process, following rules apply:
 - Prioritize the ones who have been in contact with us (Kristin Andersen) before the deadline.
 - Do not fund companies at risk , we check eligibility rules.
 - Prioritize "new " partners within the call, if you participate in two funded AAL2021-projects, we will ask you to choose, to free up a slot for others.
 - Prioritize according to the AAL ranking-list, we will fund the proposal with the higher score.



NATIONAL GRANT PROCEDURE

- AAL centrally evaluate and offers contract negotiations, the project with Norwegian partners or coordinator do not have to go through a national evaluation.
- If granted, each Norwegian participant needs to submit a proposal to us (routine, easy procedure) , in order to start the contract with RCN

General eligibility criteria and conditions for project funding from the Research Council of Norway will apply:

- The recipient must be a registered legal entity
- Demonstrate financial viability
- Provide transparency as to funding requested or received from other sources



NORWEGIAN FUNDING RATES

* The funding of the Norwegian partners together in one AAL project cannot exceed 50 % of eligible costs.
